History of Flood Control District

- Arizona State Legislature established the District in 1959
- Mission: To keep County residents safe from flood hazards
- District designated as a special taxing district by state legislation
- Funds are allocated for flood control features throughout Maricopa County




ADMS Purpose

- Broad-brush look at environmental, cultural settings, landscape character, and open space

- Involve Public




ADMP Purpose

- Blueprint for mitigating hazards and implementing projects
- Coordinate plans between jurisdictions
- Involve Stakeholders
- Involve Public



Hohokam ADMS/P

- Approximately 28 Sq. Miles
- Salt River to North, South Mountain to South
- Urbanized Area




Background

- No current overall drainage study for the area
- Recommended for ADMS/P study
- ADMS/P study started May 2010



Status of Project

- Currently in ADMS phase
 - Data collection
 - Identify existing drainage issues
 - Technical analysis
 - Conduct Stakeholder and Public meetings

- Finalize Technical Analysis
- Formulate Ideas/Alternatives
- Phase II tasks:
 - Analyze Alternatives
 - Continue Public Meetings
 - Continue Stakeholder Involvement
 - Recommend a Final Alternative
- Future design and construction
