Road Closure Advisory

1/20/14 through 3/30/14

Beginning at 6 a.m., Monday, January 20, 2014, the Flood Control District of Maricopa County (District) contractor will temporarily close the following roads to construct a concrete box drainage culvert:

- Broadway Road, Citrus Road to 175th Avenue**
- Elwood Street, 175th Avenue to Cotton Lane**
- 175th Avenue, Broadway Road to Elwood Street**

During this time, Citrus Road will remain open. Lower Buckeye Road or MC85 may be used as an alternate route. The roads will reopen by 4 p.m., Sunday, March 30, 2014.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your patience during this improvement effort.

About the Project

The District awarded a contract to FNF Construction, Inc. to construct the Loop 303 Outfall Drainage System. The new outfall drainage system will collect and carry stormwater runoff to the Gila River and reduce the chance of property damage and flooding of the future freeway and adjacent areas during a major storm event. Drainage improvements include construction of a concrete-lined channel, box culverts, storm drain pipe, retaining walls and landscaping. Additional improvements include street and irrigation system reconstruction for the Roosevelt Irrigation District and Buckeye Water Conservation and Drainage District. The project is slated for completion in fall 2015.

Safety Is Number One

Please drive cautiously, obey flag persons and special construction signs and do not move any barricades. Barricades are placed to provide for the safety of commuters and crews working on the project. In addition, do not go into the construction work area until the project is completed for your safety and the safety of others.
