Traffic Restrictions Planned Lower Buckeye Road at Cotton Lane 9/2/14 through 9/12/14

Beginning 5 a.m., Monday, September 2, 2014, the Flood Control District of Maricopa County (District) contractor will restrict traffic to one lane in each direction on Lower Buckeye Road at Cotton Lane to install storm drain pipe. During this time, northbound and southbound traffic on Cotton Lane will not be restricted. Please obey construction barricades, signs and flag persons when driving through the construction zone. Access will be maintained for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles at all times; however, expect traffic delays and allow extra time to drive through the work area. Yuma Road or Cotton Lane may be used as an alternate route. Lower Buckeye Road will reopen by 5 p.m., Friday, September 12, 2014, weather permitting.

Road Closure Through 9/5/14 Van Buren Street: Citrus Road to Cotton Lane


The District contractor has closed Van Buren Street between Citrus Road and Cotton Lane to complete the box culvert installation. During this time, Citrus Road and Cotton Lane will remain open. Yuma Road, Citrus Road or Cotton Lane may be used as an alternate route. Van Buren Street will reopen by 6 p.m., Friday, September 5, 2014.

About the Project

The District awarded a contract to FNF Construction, Inc. to construct the Loop 303 Outfall Drainage System. The new outfall drainage system will collect and carry stormwater runoff to the Gila River and reduce the chance of property damage and flooding to the future freeway and adjacent areas during a major storm event. Drainage improvements include construction of a concrete-lined channel, box culverts, storm drain pipe, retaining walls and landscaping. Additional improvements include street and irrigation system reconstruction for the Roosevelt Irrigation District (RID) and Buckeye Water Conservation and Drainage District (BWCD). The project is slated for completion in fall 2015.
