Public Meetings to Discuss Flooding in N. Paradise Valley and Portions of N.E. Phoenix

The Flood Control District of Maricopa County (FCD) will hold two public meetings to identify areas of flooding in Paradise Valley, and portions of northeast Phoenix. The input received from residents who attend will help FCD, town and city officials prepare a plan to provide potential solutions for the flood-prone areas identified through the study.

The study, called the Middle Indian Bend Wash Area Drainage Master Study/Plan (MIBW ADMS/P) covers northern Paradise Valley and portions of northeast Phoenix; bound by the Central Arizona Project canal to the north, the ridgelines of the Phoenix Mountains Preserve to the south, the eastern boundary of the Upper East Fork of Cave Creek ADMS study to the west and the Lower Indian Bend Wash ADMS to the south (see map).

MIBW ADMS/P is a regional drainage study that identifies potential flood hazards and solutions for problems in the study area. This area was last studied in 1978 as part of the Paradise Valley-Scottsdale-Phoenix study, which covered 64 square miles.

Residents living in these areas are invited to attend one of two open house meetings where representatives from the Flood Control District of Maricopa County, City of Phoenix, and the Town of Paradise Valley will be available to answer questions about the study process.


