Photo 3.5 Patterson Rd & Old US 80 Intersection ^{12/26/67}

The Gillespie irrigation canal was constructed without sufficient siphons, culverts, floodways etc to allow floodwater to pass. This floodwater build up behind the canal bank and then washes it out taking along with it bridges, culverts and sections of Old US 80. This condition has existed for many years. It is costly and dangerous.

The owners of this irrigation ditch should not be allowed to rebuild it until they make plans to provide for this cross drainage. Some one may get killed because of this.

charged for years that North Vietnamese regulars were aiding the Communist Pathet Lao forces in the northern parts of Laos near the North Vietnamese border.

A SOUTH Vietnam government announcement also said the four days of truce could be extended if they might lead to "fruitful results" in talks with North Vietnam.

"Fruitful results" was not defined. It appeared to mean peace talks, observers said.

The statement said the allies will observe a one-day truce at Christmas, one at New Year's and two days at the Asian lunar new year (Tet) late in January. The Viet Cong sought a 13-day truce period.

Airport Open

CHICAGO (AP) — Regularly scheduled airline passenger service returned today to Midway Airport after a four and one-half month layoff for completion of a \$4-million construction program.

No Heavy Runoff In Area, Says SRP

Salt River Project officials said today the storm has produced no appreciable runoff into the reservoirs that supply Valley cities and farmlands.

"There is more available storage capacity (over 700,000 acre feet) in reservoirs on the Salt and Verde rivers than we have had in the past two years," a spokesman said.

ALL WATER from the reservoirs into the canal system has been shut off since yesterday. Pumps are being used to supply municipal water needs. The water now in the canals is runoff from the storm, and it is being drained as rapidly as possible into rivers and creeks.

Wasteways, which carry excess water out of the canals, have been open since last night. Evergreen wasteway, east of Scottsdale, is discharging water into the Salt River at a rate of 100 cubic feet per second; Joint Head wasteway, just east of 48th Street, is dis-

charging water into the river at the rate of 225 cubic feet per second.

ON THE WEST side of the Valley, water is being discharged into Skunk Creek (about one-half mile north of Greenway Road on 75th Avenue) from the end of the Arizona Canal at a rate of 100 cubic feet per second. Water is being released into New River from the end of the Grand canal at 107th Avenue and Bethany Home Road at a rate of 75 cubic feet per second.

City storm drains are discharging about 75 cubic feet of water per second into the Salt River.

No projections have yet been made on the potential runoff into reservoirs since a survey at snow gauging stations in the northern and eastern parts of the state will not be made until the storm has passed.




