



The County spent \$513 per person, compared to \$1,280 spent per person for benchmark counties.




Public Safety (48%) Health (24%) Capital Projects (14%)

■ General Government* (7%) ■ Highways & Streets (3%)


Debt Payments (1%) Parks, Libraries, & Education (3%)
