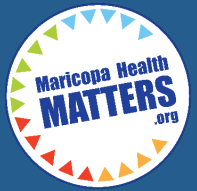

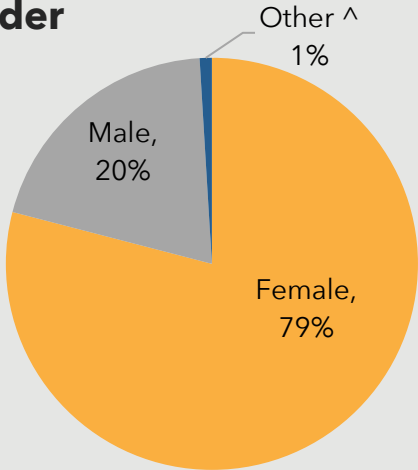

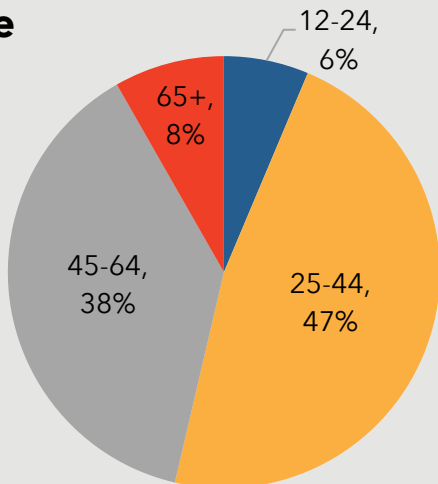

Who took the survey in Zone 5?

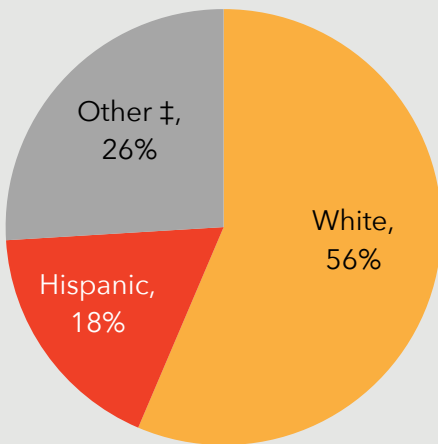

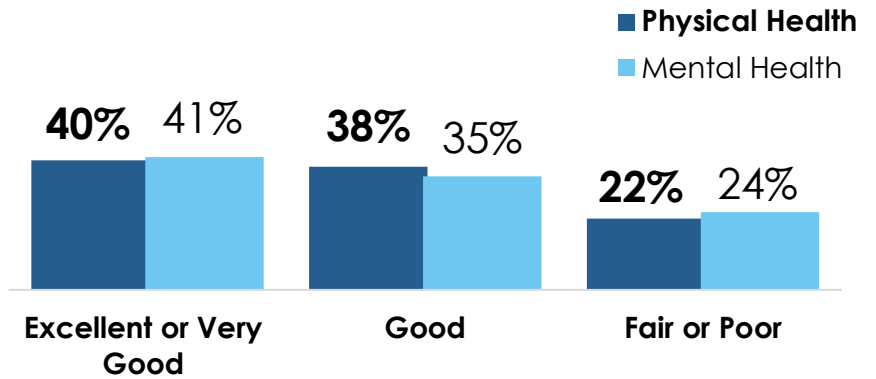

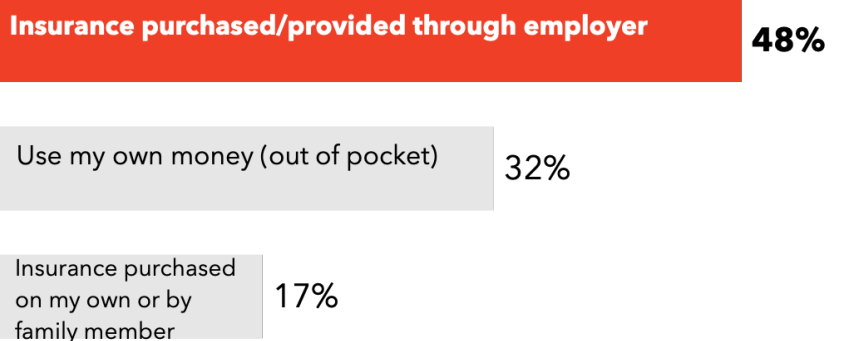
SOMETIMES or **NEVER** have enough money to pay for essentials such as food, clothing and housing
