Who: Maricopa County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) has commissioned the 115th/117th Avenue Corridor Improvement Study (CIS) to identify potential short- and long-term improvements along the corridor to address concerns and ongoing development.

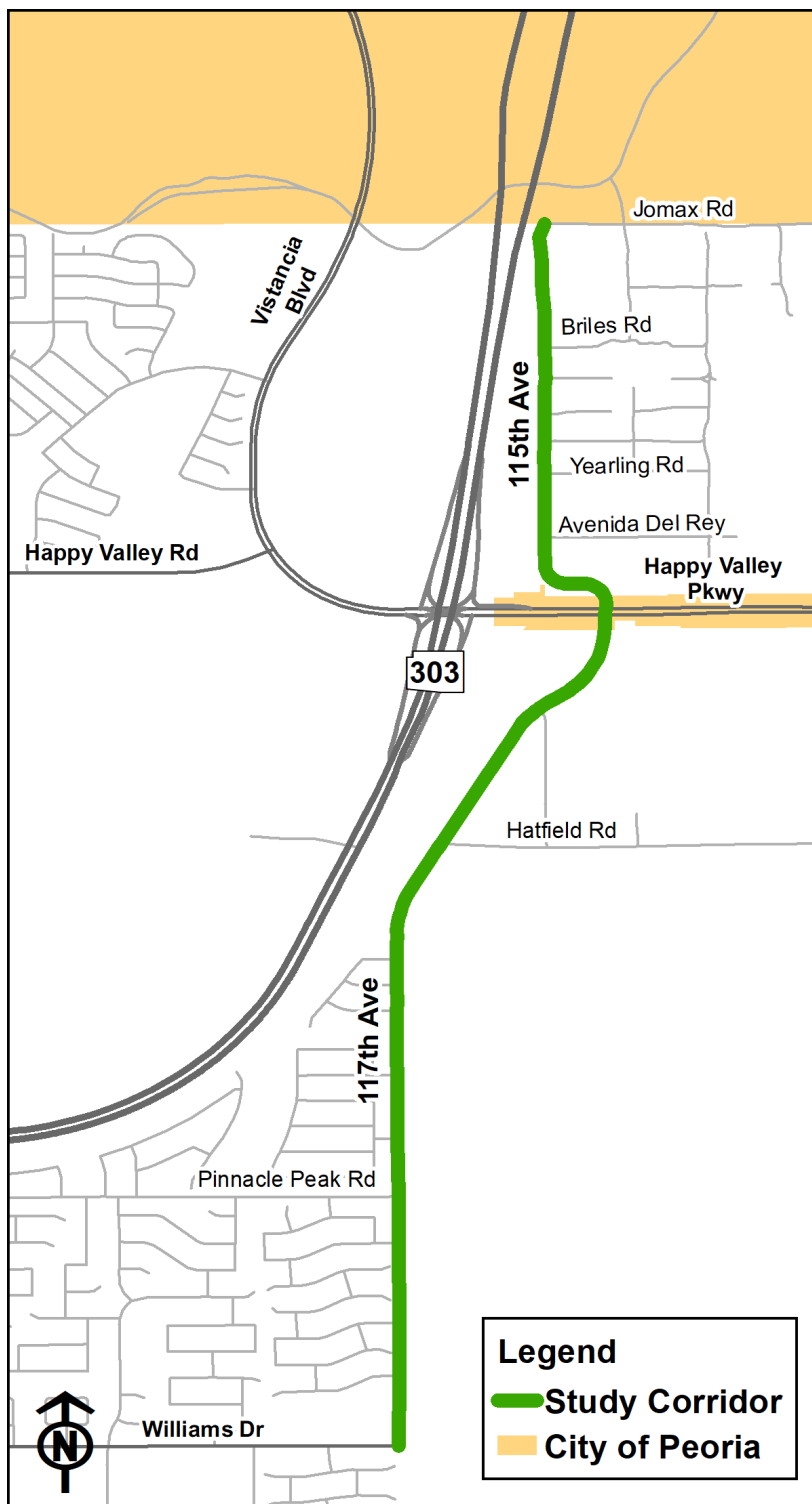
Study Area: The study area includes a one-mile buffer of 115th Avenue/117th Avenue from Williams Drive to Jomax Road alignment, approximately 2.50 miles in length, as shown in the map. The study area includes the Happy Valley Parkway intersection that is within the City of Peoria Municipal Limits.

The project team is looking for input on the alternatives being considered to ultimately determine a preferred alternative for the corridor.
